Our itinerary will include choral services at some or all of the Cathedrals at Gloucester, Hereford and Worcester where the choirs are all in top form at present. The organs in the first two places have been rebuilt since our last visit to the area in 1995 and in Worcester there is a wonderful 2008 four manual organ by Kenneth Tickell. Among other places, we are also investigating the possibility of visiting Tewkesbury Abbey, Ludlow PC, Great Malvern Priory, St Woolos’ Cathedral, Newport and Llandaff Cathedral (Cardiff) where a large new organ by Nicholson & Co. is due to be dedicated next Easter. We hope to fly out from Aldergrove to Bristol at 10:10 on Saturday and return from Cardiff at 18:30 on Monday. Our accommodation is likely to be in Worcester city centre.
